Google Classroom

We will be using Google Classroom as a platform to provide daily work to all our students from Years 7 – 10 Monday-Thursday.

Students will need to use the unique code sent to parents via text message to join their year group class.

Google Classroom can be used from your home PC, tablet or smartphones.

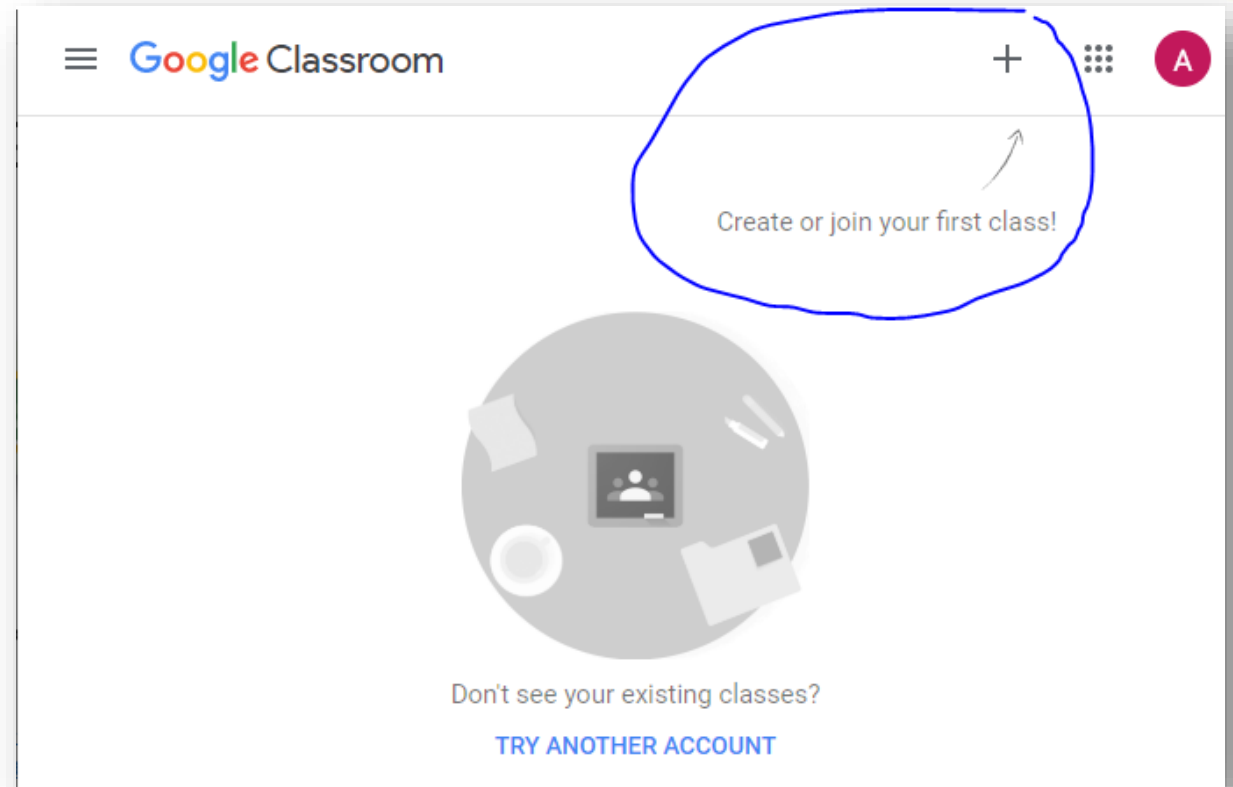

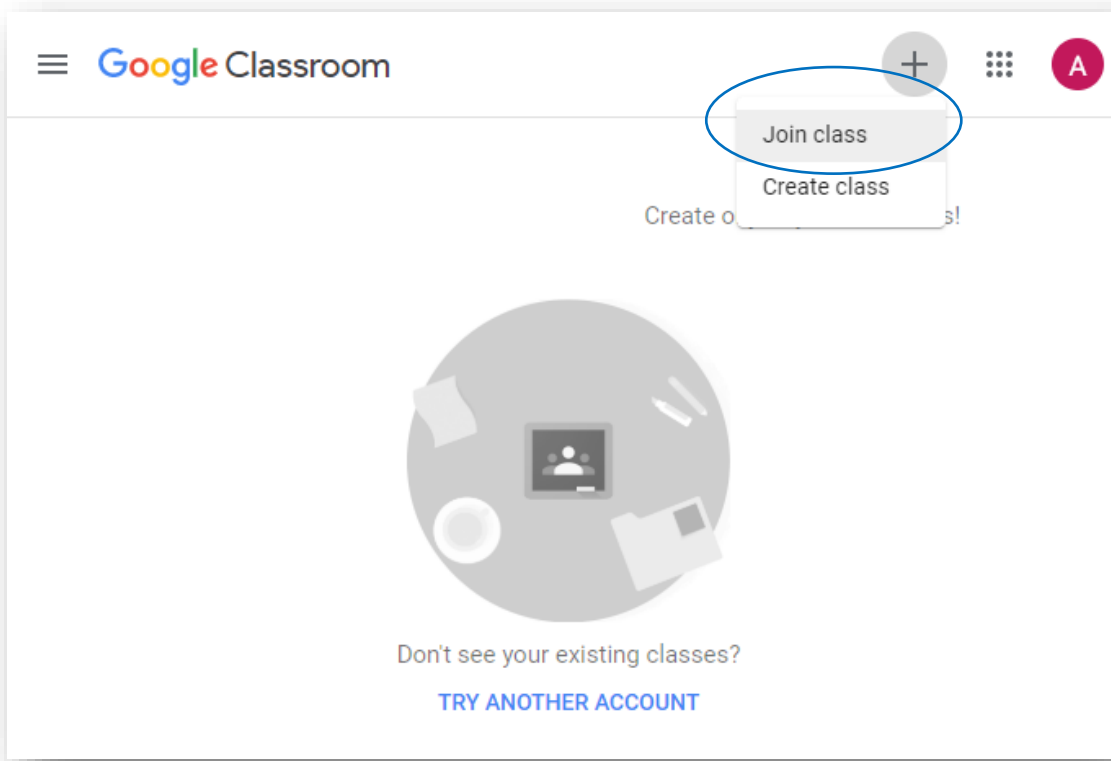

Type in classroom.google.com on the search and then click the + symbol on top right of page. You will need to sign in with your email account to access this page.

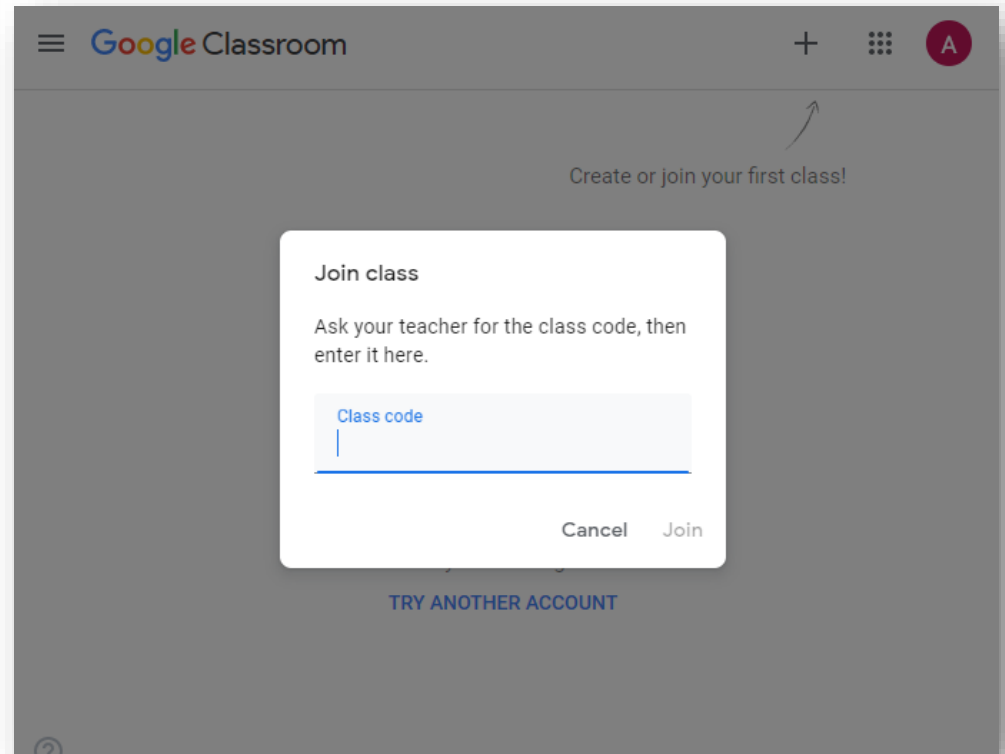

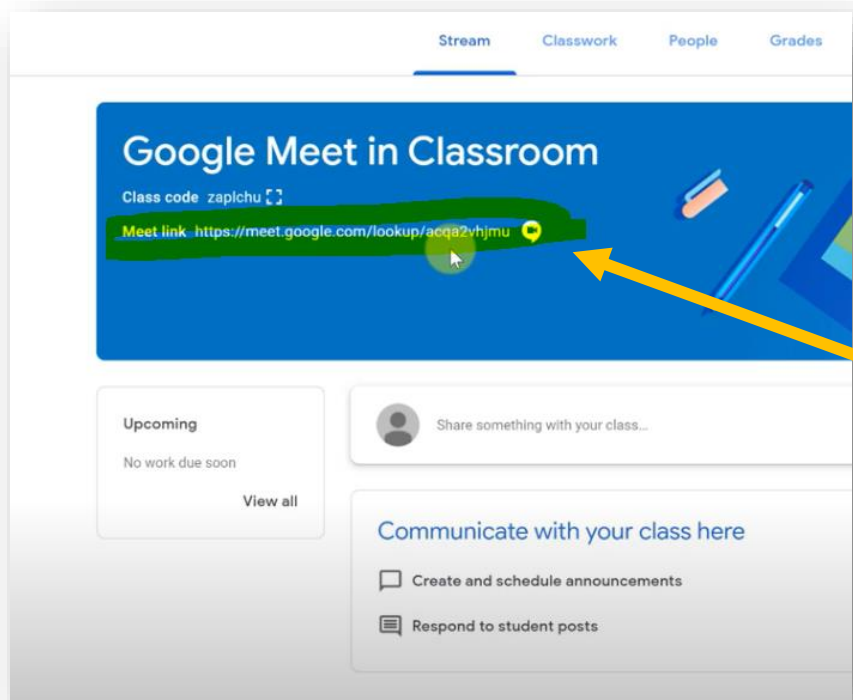
Click on join class

And then enter the unique access code provided to you via text message.

Once the video teaching session is enabled by the teacher, students can see the video link, as shown on the left image.

Classwork

All academic work will be available for students on the Classroom menu.



Each work will have documents attached to complete with full instructions given by the teacher daily.

Some work may have video links to enhance learning.

All completed work should be returned again for marking. Teachers will give feedback on the completed work for all students.

Communication

Students will be given opportunity to send messages to the teacher regarding work, using Google Classroom.

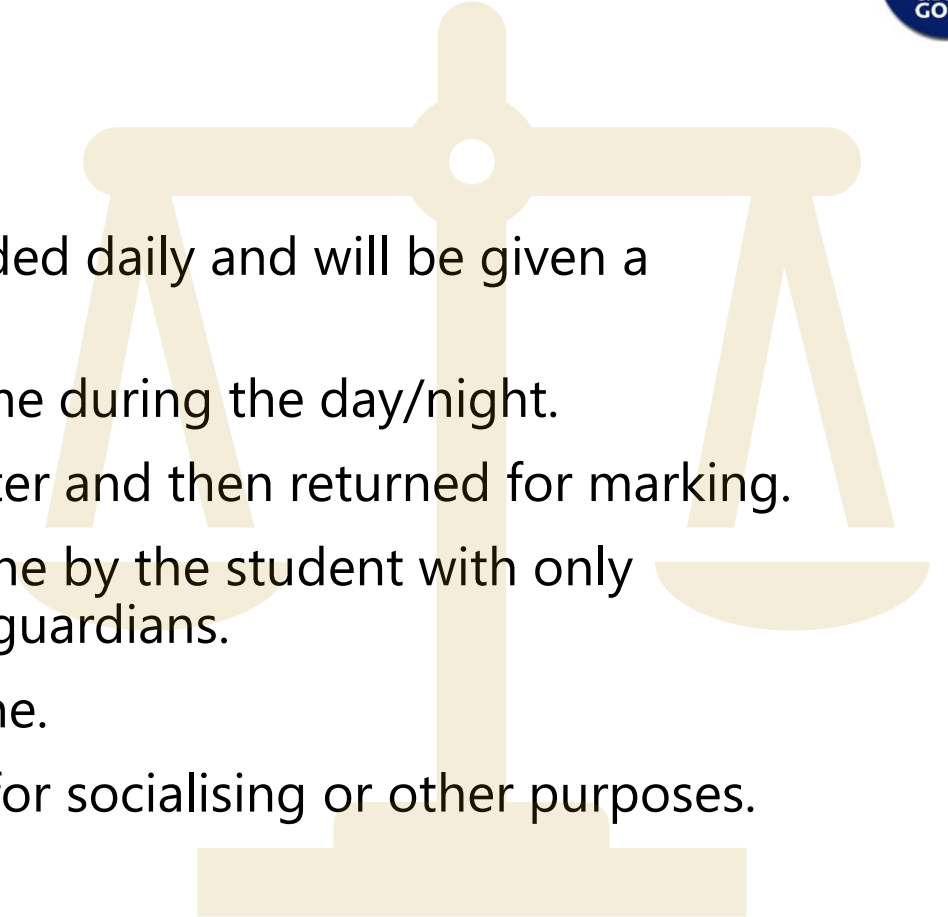


If you have any questions or stuck on a piece of work, you can send a quick message for your teacher who will provide further support.

Important notes:



- Work for several subjects will be uploaded daily and will be given a target deadline to complete this.
- Students may access the work at anytime during the day/night.
- Work can be completed on the computer and then returned for marking.
- Please ensure all completed work is done by the student with only essential support provided by parents/guardians.
- Please supervise all children when online.
- Google classroom should not be used for socialising or other purposes.

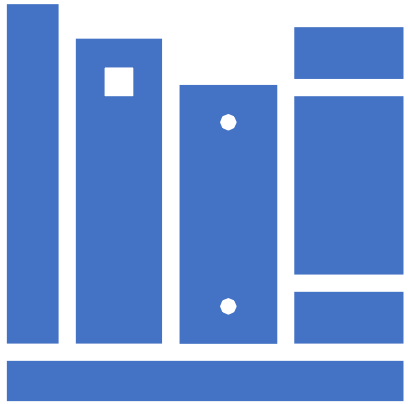


Safeguarding
